Summer Food Service Program Scholarship

The New York Conference of the Free Methodist Church announces its **summer camping program** for 2009 at Camp Timberledge. The camp is located outside Beach Lake, PA and provides Christian, counselor-centered programs open to all children and youth. The **summer camping schedule** is as follows:

Junior Camp (for those entering 4th or 5th grade) July 12-18

Intermediate Camp (for those entering 6th or 7th grade) July 19-25

Young Teen Camp (for those entering 8th or 9th grade) July 26-August 1

Senior Teen Camp (for those entering 10th grade through high school) August 2-8
